



Call for Expressions of Interest Edmonton Heritage Council Camsell Hospital Video Project

June 15, 2016

Understanding of Edmonton's history must include more than just the documented, colonial narrative that dominates our understanding of the past. In 2015, the Edmonton Heritage Council (EHC) made a renewed commitment to reconciliation by working to animate a fuller understanding of our city's history from all perspectives.

In Spring 2016, EHC began this work with a focus on bringing together stories from the Charles Camsell Indian Hospital to begin to tell this site's history through the lens of reconciliation. At the Camsell Hospital Research Symposium in April, EHC brought together former patients and their families along with academic researchers, former hospital staff, community members, and representatives from government and Indigenous organizations to share perspectives on the hospital and begin to consider how to share this story with others.

The Edmonton Heritage Council is looking to produce a short digital video to gather and share what we learned through the Symposium to keep the conversation of reconciliation moving forward in our city.

Scope

Produce a high quality, web-based video, approximately 12 minutes in length.

Content

Desired content for the video will be provided by the Edmonton Heritage Council and may include historical images and footage, personal interviews, and on-location filming.

Video Equipment

The contractor is responsible for providing all video equipment.

Production Facilities and Costs

The costs associated with the production of the video, including booking facilities, are the responsibility of the contractor. EHC may be able to provide protocol and honorariums for personal interview participants.

Timeline

The video must be completed by August 15, 2016. All related invoices for this project must be paid by August 31, 2016 due to funding restrictions.

Budget

Edmonton Heritage Council has \$10,000 budgeted for this project.
